


Stashbusting Baby Footie for Mid Gauge Silver Reed with Video!



This is a variation on [14 Minute Slippers](#) by Sarah Coates found on the Northtipton site. Wonderful site that folks should visit, wonderful information and services are available there. It may also be found in this smaller and unlined style somewhere else. Wonderful short row decrease and increase practice. Make in batches and give as gifts or to charitable groups. A video accompanies this unabbreviated pattern.

Machine: LK-150/Mid-Gauge **Tools:** 2-3 Claw Weights, Tapestry Needle, Scissors
Yarn: Worsted Weight  **Stitch Dial:** 7● (stitch dial is set on the ● after the 7)
Techniques: E-wrap ❖ Automatic Wrap Short Row ❖ Threaded/Gathered Cast off

❖ Beginning Steps

Carriage on right Row Counter 000

E-Wrap Cast on 14 needles (7Left - 0 - 7Right)

Set Russell Levers on both sides to || (allows needles in hold to knit)

Knit one Row Carriage on left Row Count 001

❖ Heel Shaping

Set Russell Levers on both sides to | (Setting stops needles in Hold Position from knitting)

Move 1st needle in work on left hand side to Hold Position

Knit one row Carriage on Right

Move 1st needle in work on right hand side to Hold Position

Knit one row Carriage on left

Continue moving 1st needle in working position to Hold Position on carriage side to hold until 4 needles remain in work

Carriage on left Row Count 11

Place 1st Holding needle opposite side of carriage to Forward Working Position (Needle # 5 Right of 0)

Repeat after each row until all needles are in working position

Carriage on left Row Count 21

❖ Toe Shaping

Move 1st needle in work on left hand side to Hold Position

Knit one row Carriage on Right

Move 1st needle in work on left hand side to Hold Position

Knit one row Carriage on left

Continue moving 1st needle in working position to Hold Position on carriage side to hold until 4 needles remain in work

Carriage on left Row Count 31

Place 1st needle out of work opposite side of carriage into Forward Working Position

Repeat after each row until all needles are in working position

Carriage on Left Row Count 41

❖ Finishing

Knit one Row Carriage on Right Row Count 42

Cut yarn just above carriage.

Pick up the first stitch from each side and hang on edge needle

Cut a second length of yarn approximately 25" long

Thread Tapestry needle doubling the yarn

Thread tapestry needle through each stitch on the needles

Remove work from machine

Turn work right side out

Gather stitches by pulling on the ends of the threaded yarn tightly

Collect the beginning and ending yarn pieces you should have 3 pieces of yarn to tie off

Tie a double knot to hold this in place. Finish by trimming or creating a bow.

1 Footie completed.

❖ Repeat for second Footie.
